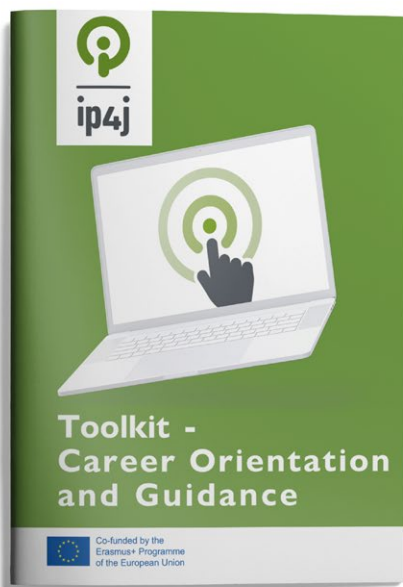

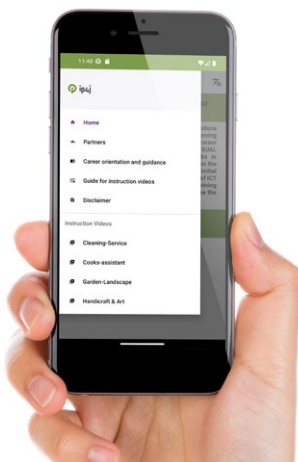
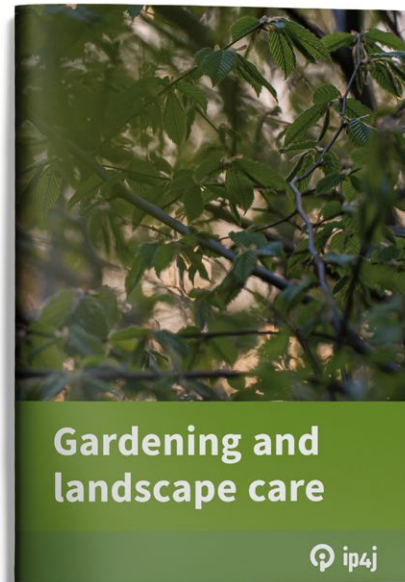
Video tutorials
